

## **VOLUNTARY INTERNSHIP, AUTISM RESEARCH CENTRE, CAMBRIDGE UNIVERSITY**

Applications are invited for a voluntary internship at the Autism Research Centre (ARC) (Department of Psychiatry, University of Cambridge) to work on a project focusing on the effects of intranasal oxytocin in people with and without autism spectrum conditions (ASC).

The intern will support Dr Bonnie Auyeung. The main role will be to assist in psychological testing at the Addenbrooke's Clinical Research Centre, which includes cognitive and language assessments. The role would suit someone wishing to gain experience in psychological research.

The successful applicant must have an undergraduate degree (minimum 2:1) in psychology or an allied discipline. We particularly welcome applicants who have an honorary contract with the NHS. The internship is full time and is expected to last for a period of three months in the first instance. The successful applicant will be required to undergo an enhanced CRB check.
